# TRAP METAL RAP ARTIST KILL DYLL RELEASES NEW SINGLE & MUSIC VIDEO "VOID" FEATURING SLOWBOY

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### **NEW EP ANTAGONIST ARRIVES ON FEBRUARY 23RD**



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February 9, 2024 (Los Angeles, CA) – Stirring up a chaotic sonic blend without comparison, trap metal artist Kill Dyll teams up with innovative Norwegian producer and leading Brazilian Phonk architect Slowboy on an incendiary new single and music video entitled "VOID." The track arrives ahead of Kill Dyll's major label debut EP, ANTAGONIST which drops on February 23rd via Second Estate / Warner Records. Grimy industrial metal guitars, pummeling basement-born rap beats, Brazilian Phonk rhythms, and guttural vocals collide on "VOID." As if traveling out of the underworld at full speed, the track charges forward, fueled by **Kill Dyll**'s battle-ready screams.

Directed by MOLDYROOM and shot in New York, the accompanying visual reflects this mood. **Kill Dyll** presides over a cult-like following deep in the woods. A gothic aesthetic sets the mood as this cohort rushes to literally feast upon him. What follows proves to be repulsive and transfixing in equal measure. Once again, it sees Kill Dyll scale new heights with teeth bared and claws out.

**Kill Dyll** launched the year with a bang. He just joined forces with Witchouse 40K on "FEAST." Right out of the gate, <u>The Pit</u> hailed it as "a total assault from front to back" and went on to rave, "Kill Dyll leans into trap metal's most aggressive evolution, taking things a leap forward past what his contemporaries are up to."

"FEAST" arrived soon after the release of the unnerving tracks "Paranoia" and "TIMMY." In addition to amassing tens of millions of streams, Kill Dyll delivers a sound that defies genres, encouraging listeners and newcomers to dig deeper.

Subversion is most definitely an art form, and Kill Dyll is painting his masterpiece in 2024.
