

It serves as the follow-up to his recent worldwide anthem "Attention" featuring Grammy®-winning global superstar Justin Bieber. The latter has already amassed over 63.8 million total streams and over 18.6 million YouTube views on the music video. In addition to plugs from HYPEBEAST, The FADER, and more, Billboard praised, "Omah effortlessly lets the last word of each line roll off his tongue to the point where it's more felt than heard." UPROXX asserted "Omah Lay is primed to be a big contributor towards another successful

year for Afrobeats."

"Attention" was the 25-year-old singer's first single of 2022. Omah Lay kept busy throughout 2021 with a steady stream of releases and a sold-out US tour. In November, he shared the buttery "Free My Mind." His smash hit "Understand" from July was a contemplative, yet danceable record powered by his signature vocal warmth. In June 2021, he was featured on Masterkraft's remix of Bieber's chart-topping "Peaches."
