October 13, 2023 (Los Angeles, CA) -Veeze has just shared the deluxe version of his critically acclaimed debut album *Ganger*. Adding five extra songs to the original tracklist, the deluxe is highlighted by a production credit from Surf Gang's Evilgiane on "Luv the Tour," as well as a continuous stream of Veeze's signature sludgy flows and animated bar work that finds him delivering a cannon of niche sports and pop culture references. "Why the fuck I'm smokin' dope and ballin', Lamar Odom / How you supposed to catch up if you keep on startin' over / Why you never around everytime I need you, Paul George", he raps on "Rich Rockstar," while using a track like "Get Lucki" to reflect on his come-up and musical evolution while embracing the rockstar lifestyle.

Veeze dropped the highly-anticipated <u>Ganger</u> at the end of June this year, which was backed by one of the biggest rap songs of the year in <u>"GOMD"</u> (37M+ Streams), and its remix with <u>Lil Uzi Vert</u>. Serving as only Veeze's second full-length release – after 2019's <u>Navy Wavy</u>, Ganger was highlighted by other standout tracks like the anthemic <u>"Not a Drill"</u> (16M+ Streams) and <u>"Safe 2," quickly being met with critical acclaim from the upper echelon of music media like <u>Pitchfork</u>, <u>Rolling Stone</u>, <u>The Washington Post</u>, and others. As an accumulation of Veeze's artistic evolution across its original 21 songs with features from Lil Yachty, Lil Uzi Vert, LUCKI, Babyface Ray, and Icewear Vezzo, <u>Ganger finds Veeze fully committing to his signature syrupy flows and witty lyricism over an eclectic batch of beats. <u>The Ganger Tour</u>, which kicked off in front of a sold-out crowd in NY on 10/10, has other sold-out dates in Los Angeles, Atlanta, Detroit, and more, with Anycia joining him as an opener.</u></u>



ABOUT VEEZE:

Veeze, the mysterious Detroit, Michigan rapper has managed to captivate audiences, critics, and peers alike while simultaneously developing a rare devoted cult following. Kicked off by the aweinspiring 2020 single "Law N Order" (23M+ Streams), a song that reinvented the famed theme song of Law & Order and transformed it into a hard-knocks Detroit anthem that's defined the city's fresh sound — Veeze has emerged as Hip-Hop's people's champion, as his career now serves as a blueprint for experimentation and ingenuity across generations and regions. Since first breaking out of the Detroit scene with his 2019 debut mixtape Navy Wavy – Veeze has slowly shown his cards as a staple of the city and beyond with singles like <u>"Rusty"</u> (15M+ Streams), <u>"Kurt</u> Angle" (5M+ Steams), "Choppas In Hawaii" (4M+ Streams), as well as choice features like "Gallery <u>Dept"</u> & <u>"Spending Spree"</u> – both alongside longtime friend and collaborator Babyface Ray. He also served as a key collaborator on Lil Yachty's Detroit-flavored 2021 album Michigan Boy Boat, lending his talents on "Fight Night Round 3" alongside Babyface Ray and "Don't Even Bother" with Baby Smoove. Veeze's homegrown traction first culminated in June of 2022 when he made his debut on the Billboard Hot 100 with his stellar collaboration "U-Digg" alongside his close collaborators and associates Lil Baby & 42 Dugg. Where he diverges from his peers is his desire for anonymity and aversion from the spotlight. Although co-signed by the likes of Drake, Future, James Harden, Lil Baby, and many more – he rarely puts himself on a public pedestal and is intently calculated with his releases, creating a certain mythology behind his artistry. Staunchly championed by the upper-echelon of Hip-Hop media, including everyone from Rolling Stone and Pitchfork to The FADER and Billboard, and tediously mentored by the greats of our era, Veeze has all the markings of a superstar in the making. After years of casually being Hip-Hop's best-kept secret, 2023 has found Veeze taking his career to the next level with the release of his critically-acclaimed debut album Ganger. In the words of The FADER, "Veeze could be the best rapper in the world if he wanted to" - and now, with the release of one of Hip-Hop's most popular albums of the year, he finally does.
