



## Hobo Johnson Shares Live Performance Video of “I Want a Dog”

**November 12, 2019 (Los Angeles, CA)** - Back in September, Hobo Johnson released his second album [\*The Fall of Hobo Johnson\*](#) and today he shares a new live performance video for one of the most hopeful tracks on the album “I Want a Dog” [HERE](#). The visual follows other previously-released live videos including “[Mover Awayer](#)” from *The Fall* and is ultimately inspired by the original backyard visual for “Peach Scone,” which catapulted Hobo Johnson from local musician to international-artist.

Hobo Johnson is currently on the North American leg of his tour *The Fall Tour of Hobo Johnson* with his band The Lovemakers in support of the new album. Tomorrow night (November 13th), he will play in Toronto, ON and continue shows throughout November until capping off on the 30th at Ace of Spade in his hometown of Sacramento. Hobo and the band will pick back up for the international leg of the tour on December 4th and close out the year playing dates abroad (full dates below) including, shows in Germany, the U.K., the Netherlands and Australia.

**ABOUT HOBO JOHNSON:**

Hailing from Sacramento, CA, artist Frank Lopes, who cultivated the moniker Hobo Johnson after being kicked out of his parents' house and left to live in his '94 Corolla, is propelling his way to the top. The half Azorean Portuguese, quarter Mexican and Native American vocalist built a grassroots following via viral homegrown style videos showcasing his singularity; an amalgamation of spoken word poetry, punk, folk and rap backed by his band The Lovemakers. Hobo's momentum reached a tipping point after gaining feverish interest through his "Peach Scone" video entry in *NPR's* "Tiny Desk" Contest, which went viral despite not winning. Bursting with unadulterated sincerity, his genre-defying sound feels akin to musical anomalies of the past and future. 2017 saw Hobo Johnson's self-released debut album, *The Rise of Hobo Johnson*, selling out shows everywhere and amassing over 141 million cumulative U.S. streams. Hobo Johnson's impact only continues to grow with the arrival of his sophomore album, *The Fall of Hobo Johnson*.
