

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April 16, 2021 (Los Angeles, CA)– Today, GRAMMY® Award-nominated and Golden Globe-winning singer/songwriter, activist, and actress **Andra Day** shares a fresh and glowing new soul single, “**Phone Dies**” on **Warner Records**. Paired with the slick electro-soul production of “**Phone Dies**” by **.Paak**, **Andra**’s vocals radiate a heart-melting warmth. “*This must sound crazy, but be my baby,*” she coos, letting a brassy fanfare carry her into the chorus. “*It’s so amazing, being my baby. I’ll let you feel these vibes until my phone dies.*” She can’t stay for too long—but she’ll make sure you have the time of your life.

Before releasing “**Phone Dies**,” **Andra** made her feature-acting debut in Lee Daniels’ *The United States vs. Billie Holiday*. Her critically acclaimed performance as Holiday won the Golden Globe for “Best Actress in a Motion Picture, Drama” and received a coveted “Best Actress” nomination at the *Oscars*. For the soundtrack, **Andra** recorded soul-stirring covers of Holiday’s classics, like “[Strange Fruit](#)” and “[Lady Sings the Blues](#),” and the Golden Globe-nominated original, “[Tigress & Tweed](#),” a stormy, piano-driven ballad co-written with neo-soul pioneer Raphael Saadiq.

Andra was also honored at the Critics Choice Association’s third annual Celebration of Black Cinema on February 2 for her work in *The United States vs. Billie Holiday*. **Andra** also covered January’s *V Magazine*, February’s *Rolling Out*, and *W Magazine*.

It’s already been a busy year for **Andra Day** and there’s more to come. Her TV takeover continues with an unfiltered conversation on *Desus & Mero* (Showtime), an interview with Tiffany Haddish on *The Ellen Degeneres Show* (NBC) today, a chat and performance of “Phone Dies” on *Jimmy Kimmel Live!* April 19 (ABC), and a visit with *The Real* (FOX) on April 20. With a new studio album on the way **Andra** proves she has no plans of stopping anytime soon.



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ABOUT ANDRA DAY

GRAMMY® Award-nominated singer/songwriter, activist, and actress Andra Day has been bearing her heart on the world's stage for years. She was initially best known for her 2016 GRAMMY®-nominated behemoth, "Rise Up," which amassed 1 billion streams and an RIAA triple-platinum certification. And she's performed alongside everyone from Stevie Wonder and the Obamas to Nick Jonas and Alicia Keys. But recently, with her feature-acting debut in the Lee Daniels-directed biopic *The United States vs. Billie Holiday* (in which she starred as Holiday herself), she's been able to share even more of herself with the rest of us. Her affecting, acclaimed performance earned her a nomination for Best Actress at the Oscars and a Golden Globe for Actress in a Drama Motion Picture. And her winning renditions of Holiday songs and heartwarming originals on the soundtrack have won praise from critics and fans alike, including nominations for the original song "Tigress & Tweed" at both the Golden Globes and the Critics Choice Awards. In the wake of the film, she hasn't slowed down, launching a TV takeover that saw her making appearances on *The View*, *The Tonight Show*, and *The Daily Show*, among others. Last year, she worked with GiveDirectly to release "Make Your Troubles Go Away," in order to raise money to fight COVID-19 and lent her voice to support the Biden/Harris election. Her upcoming studio album and warmhearted new single "Phone Dies" continues her emotional generosity, spreading tenderness and joy to a world that needs it.
