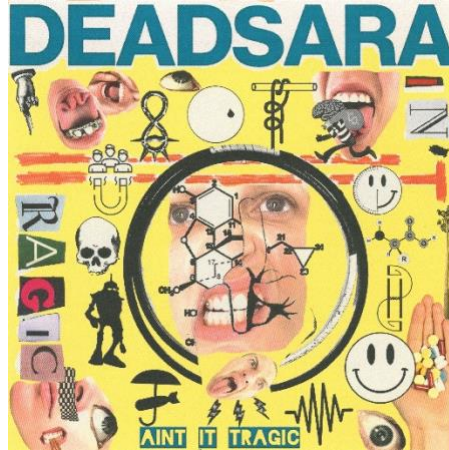


# DEADSARA

**August 27, 2021 – (Los Angeles, CA.)** – Los Angeles rock legends **Dead Sara** announce their new album *AIN'T IT TRAGIC*, set for release on Sept. 17<sup>th</sup> via Warner Records. The long-awaited, highly anticipated full-length marks their first new music since 2018's *Temporary Things Taking Up Space EP*, and contains the 2020 comeback track "[Hands Up](#)," and the new single "[Heroes](#)." Both tracks have been critically praised as "explosive" by *Loudwire* and "raw and heavy" by *Consequence of Sound*.

*AIN'T IT TRAGIC* was co-produced by **Dead Sara**'s drummer/programmer **Sean Friday** along with **Noah Shain**, who previously produced, mixed, and engineered the band's previous full-length albums, *Dead Sara* (2012) and *Pleasure To Meet You* (2015). The 11-song strong album spotlights the group's signature dual guitar attack cuts deep as firebrand front women **Emily Armstrong** (vocals/guitar/songwriter) and **Siouxie Medley** (guitars/backing vocals) trailblaze intense yet melodic verses/choruses throughout. Largely written and recorded during lockdown in Los Angeles, *AIN'T IT TRAGIC* reveals a band at the apex of their songwriting prowess with a penchant for earworm melodies, hard-hitting twin-guitar assault, masterful drumming with generous doses of energy and attitude that have made the band live legends for the past decade.

*"Deep in the making of this album, in the thick of the pandemic, we had nothing to do but write and record music," says Armstrong. "Amid all that was happening in the world and the day-in day-out in the studio we let our guards down and let whatever happen, happen... losing our minds."*

### **About Dead Sara:**

**Emily Armstrong** (vocalist/guitars/songs), **Siouxsie Medley** (guitars/backing vocals), **Sean Friday** (drummer/programmer/co-producer) first broke through with their 2012 single "[Weatherman](#)"—a churning stew of punky riffs, with chugging hard rock grooves, and throat-shredding vocals that reached No. 30 on *Billboard's* Mainstream Rock chart and was followed by tour dates supporting Muse. "**Hands Up**" was the first new music from **Dead Sara** since September 2018, when the band released a stripped-down version of "[Anybody](#)," a single originally found on [Temporary Things Taking Up Space](#). That EP built on the success of 2015's [Pleasure to Meet You](#), which reached No. 2 on *Billboard's* Heatseekers chart and No. 7 on the Hard Rock Albums chart. To date, **Dead Sara** has been featured on *Rolling Stone*, *Interview*, *Guitar World*, *Loudwire*, and more and performed at the GRAMMY Museum. **Dead Sara** is back in a big way. Look for **Dead Sara** to tour the world in 2021 & 2022.
